- Reusable water bottle (fill post-security)
- ☐ Mini umbrella (for sun or unexpected drizzle)
- ☐ Ziplock bag for snacks or wet items
- ☐ Snacks (granola bar, nuts, trail mix)
- ☐ Small tote or daypack
- Neck pillow (for flights or rooftop rest)
- ☐ Eye mask & earplugs
- ☐ Reusable shopping bag (for Myeongdong market finds)
- ☐ Compact laundry or shoe bag

General Travel Tips & Reminders

- Charge all devices the night before you fly
- ✓ Check Gyeongbokgung's Guard Changing Ceremony schedule (around 10 AM)
- ☑ Renting a hanbok gets you free palace entry
- ✓ Keep passport and hotel details accessible in your day bag
- ☑ Bring a pen for customs forms and guestbook sign-ins
- ☑ Dress in layers to adapt to warm afternoons and breezy evenings
- Stay hydrated and leave space in your bag for unique Seoul souvenirs
