🇫🇷 Where to Stay (Mid-Price Hotel)

Hotel Recommendation:

Hotel Le Relais Montmartre – ~\$150–\$200/night

A charming boutique hotel tucked in the romantic Montmartre district. Quiet cobblestone streets, cozy rooms, and just a short walk to Sacré-Cœur.

🕒 8:00 AM – Start the Day with Breakfast

Location: Le Pain Quotidien – Montmartre

Meal: Coffee & fresh croissant or tartine (~€8–€10 per person)



Fuel up with fresh French bread, jam, and café crème at this cozy spot near your hotel.

🕒 9:00 AM – Explore Montmartre & Sacré-Cœur

Attraction: Basilica of Sacré-Cœur (Free Entry)

Best Photo Spot: Capture the sunrise or early morning light from the steps in front of the basilica—panoramic views of Paris.



Stroll through Montmartre's romantic streets: Place du Tertre (artists' square), Rue de l'Abreuvoir (one of the prettiest streets), and don't miss La Maison Rose for the perfect Parisian backdrop.



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🕒 11:00 AM – Head to the Seine & Notre-Dame

Take the **Metro Line 4** to Cité Station (~€2.10 fare)

Attraction: Notre-Dame Cathedral (Exterior only while under renovation—free)

Best Photo Spot: Square Jean XXIII (behind the cathedral) for a peaceful garden view with gothic details.



🕒 12:00 PM – Picnic Lunch at Luxembourg Gardens

Grab lunch to-go: Pick up a sandwich or quiche and pastry from Paul bakery (~€10 per person)

Location: Jardin du Luxembourg (Free entry)

Romantic Tip: Sit near the fountain or under shaded trees for a quiet break among locals.



🕒 2:00 PM – Visit the Louvre (Outside & Courtyard)

Option 1 (Free): Admire the architecture and take romantic photos by the Louvre Pyramid

Best Photo Spot: Line up your photo with the glass pyramid centered—especially pretty with a reflection after rain.

Option 2 (Paid): Visit the museum (€17 per person) – beeline to Mona Lisa, Venus de Milo, and the romantic "Psyche Revived by Cupid's Kiss."

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🕒 4:00 PM – Walk Along the Seine + Pont des Arts

Activity: Stroll the riverside walkways (Free)

Best Photo Spot: Pont des Arts – formerly famous for “love locks,” now known for beautiful river views and the Eiffel Tower in the distance.



🕒 5:00 PM – Eiffel Tower at Golden Hour

Metro: Take Line 1 or RER C to Champ de Mars–Tour Eiffel

Attraction: Eiffel Tower (Trocadéro for photos; optional summit access: €21.50 per person for lift)

Best Photo Spot: Trocadéro Gardens at sunset—iconic view of the Eiffel Tower with fountains.

Optional: Climb or take the lift for a panoramic view. Be sure to catch the Eiffel Tower sparkle, which happens every hour on the hour after sunset.



🕒 7:30 PM – Romantic Dinner in the Latin Quarter

Restaurant: Le Petit Châtelet – near Notre-Dame, rustic, candle-lit, cozy

Meal: Prix fixe dinner of French cuisine (~€25–€30 per person with wine)

Enjoy duck confit, coq au vin, or a hearty vegetarian dish with a glass of Bordeaux.



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🕒 **9:00 PM – Evening Stroll & Seine River Cruise (Optional)**
Option (Romantic & Budget-Friendly): Vedettes du Pont Neuf
Seine Cruise – €15 per person

Glide past the Eiffel Tower, Notre-Dame, and bridges lit up beautifully by night.



🕒 **11:00 PM – End the Night Back in Montmartre**
Head back to your hotel, or stop for a nightcap at a cozy café like Le Consulat. Take one last photo on the quiet streets of Montmartre, where every corner looks like a postcard.
