# Where to Stay: Hotel G Singapore - ~\$140-\$180/night

A chic, modern boutique hotel in the Bencoolen area—great location, cozy rooms, and a short ride to key attractions. It's stylish without breaking the bank.

### 8:00 AM – Traditional Singaporean Breakfast

Location: Ya Kun Kaya Toast (near Bugis)

**Meal:** Kaya toast set with soft-boiled eggs and kopi (coffee) ~S\$6 per person

Fuel up with this local favorite—a sweet and savory start to your day.

Photo Tip: Snap a picture of your traditional breakfast tray—
Instagram loves a flat lay!





### 9:00 AM – Gardens by the Bay

Attraction: Free to explore the outdoor gardens

**Optional Add-ons:** Cloud Forest or Flower Dome (~S\$12–S\$28

each)

Walk beneath towering Supertrees and explore the lush grounds.

Best Photo Spot: Supertree Grove—go early to catch soft lighting and avoid crowds.





### 11:00 AM – Marina Bay Sands & ArtScience Museum

**Attraction:** Wander Marina Bay Promenade (Free), or visit the ArtScience Museum (~S\$19)

Explore this futuristic area together, with stunning waterfront views.

Best Photo Spot: Outside the ArtScience Museum (lotus-shaped building) with Marina Bay Sands in the background.

### 12:00 PM - Lunch at Lau Pa Sat Hawker Centre

**Meal:** Satay, Hainanese chicken rice, laksa or char kway teow (~S\$8–S\$10 per person)

Grab a seat at one of Singapore's most iconic hawker centres and enjoy authentic local dishes.

Photo Tip: The ornate colonial architecture of Lau Pa Sat makes for a charming lunch backdrop.





### 1:30 PM – Visit Chinatown or Little India

**Attraction:** Free to walk around, visit temples, and shop for souvenirs

Explore heritage shophouses, street art, and cultural temples.

Best Photo Spot: Sri Mariamman Temple or the colorful House of Tan Teng Niah in Little India.





# 3:00 PM – Explore Clarke Quay & Take a River Walk Take a slow stroll along the Singapore River, enjoying the colonial bridges, cafés, and vibrant riverside views.

Best Photo Spot: Along the bridge near Clarke Quay with colorful facades behind you.

Use 4:30 PM – Sweet Treat at The Fabulous Baker Boy Location: Fort Canning Park
Meal: Share a slice of cake and cold drinks (S\$8–S\$12)

Romantic pause in a scenic spot tucked inside Fort Canning.

**Option 1:** Singapore Flyer ride for a panoramic city view (S\$33/person)

**Option 2**: Marina Bay Sands SkyPark Observation Deck (\$\$26/person)

Best Photo Spot: Golden hour over the city from above—magical.





# 7:30 PM – Romantic Dinner at PS.Cafe at One Fullerton

**Meal:** Western-Asian fusion, beautiful waterfront dining (~S\$30–\$40 per person)

Sit outside if the weather's good and enjoy dinner with views of Marina Bay and the skyline.

### 9:00 PM – Gardens by the Bay Light Show

**Attraction**: Garden Rhapsody at Supertree Grove (Free) Watch the Supertrees come alive with music and lights in a magical nighttime display.

Best Photo Spot: Lay on the grass beneath the Supertrees and snap a wide-angle shot of the illuminated canopy.





## 10:30 PM - Nightcap or Rooftop Drink

**Location:** Smoke & Mirrors at National Gallery or Mr. Stork Rooftop Bar

Enjoy a cocktail or mocktail while admiring one last panoramic view of the city together.

### ■ 11:30 PM – Return to Hotel

Head back to Hotel G for a restful sleep after an exciting and romantic day exploring Singapore.
